- Once you have set up your BU email account, we will be able to give you access to the 'Full-Time MBA Class of 2022 Pre-Work and LAUNCH' on [QuestromTools](#). We recommend you start your mandatory academic pre-work assignments, due on August 14th, as soon as possible to allow ample time for completion. Several professors are offering office hours to answer your questions! (See below).
- For your Career Pre-work, the next deadline is July 17th. Details are on [QuestromTools](#) in the 'MBA Career Site-1st years' section.
 - Revise resume using Vmock system feedback. Then use the Network Feedback Button to request feedback from your *First Resume Reviewer*.
 - Upload your completed PML to [Handshake](#) (optional).
- Visit the [New Student web page](#) for more detailed information (including a preview of your tentative [LAUNCH schedule](#)). Please note the following changes to LAUNCH: Required content will now be delivered remotely from August 17-28 and via LfA on August 31. Some asynchronous participation will be required in advance of Monday, August 17; necessary materials will be shared the week prior.
- Upload your Terrier Card ID photo. Boston University IDs are known as Terrier Cards. Photos on these cards are additionally used on the StudentLink for identification purposes. [Please upload a picture](#) for your Terrier Card as soon as possible.
- If interested, [apply for an MBTA Fall semester pass](#) by Monday, August 10. We have learned that this process requires you to be registered for classes before applying. We anticipate registering you by Friday, August 7th. Please set a calendar reminder to apply for your MBTA pass that weekend, if interested.
- International students have or will be receiving information about [First Class](#), BU Global Programs' online noncredit pre-arrival course designed to prepare incoming students for the BU and the American classroom. Please watch your email for an invitation from BU Global Programs.
- While your semester is scheduled to end on December 15th, we recommend waiting to book airfare for that time or pursuing a flexible flight itinerary, if possible. Thank you for your understanding.
