

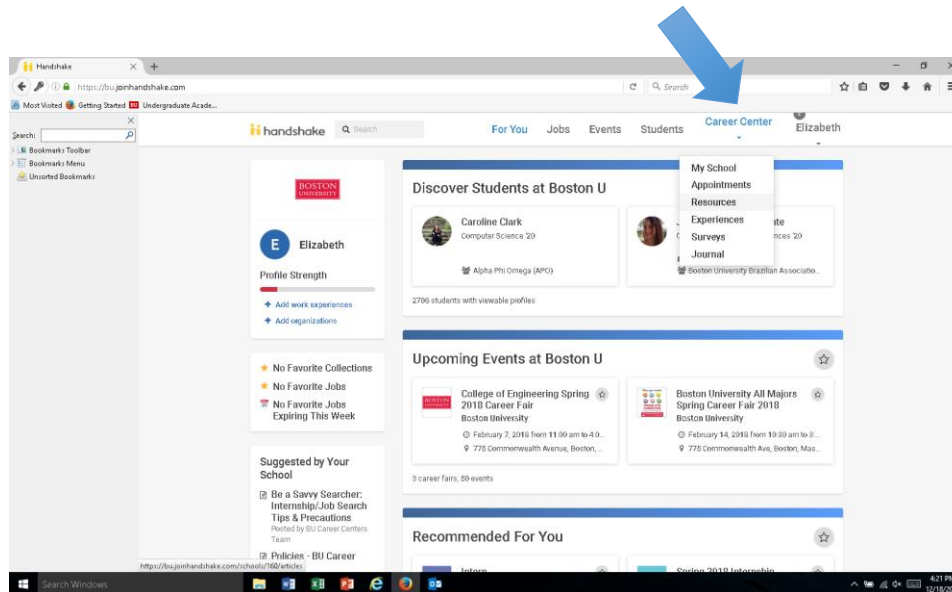
GoinGlobal How-to Guide

If you are from the U.S. and interested in working in another country, **OR** an international student looking for career opportunities in your home country, check out GoinGlobal - a robust database for researching careers abroad. This resource has information on more than 30 countries around the world, including work permit/visa regulations, resume guidelines, employment trends, salary ranges, and cultural/interviewing advice.

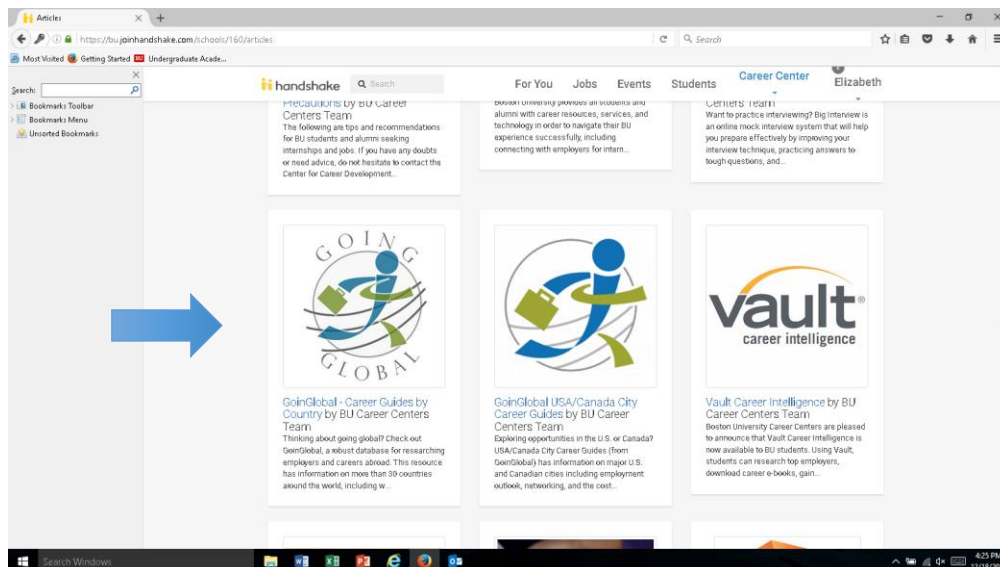
GoinGlobal's H1B Plus database provides visa information for international students who wish to work in the U.S., providing job titles, locations, and companies that have historically hired international students.

GETTING STARTED

1. Log on to Handshake at <https://app.joinhandshake.com/login>. Then, once on your homepage, move your cursor over **“Career Center”** until the drop-down appears, then click on **“Resources.”**



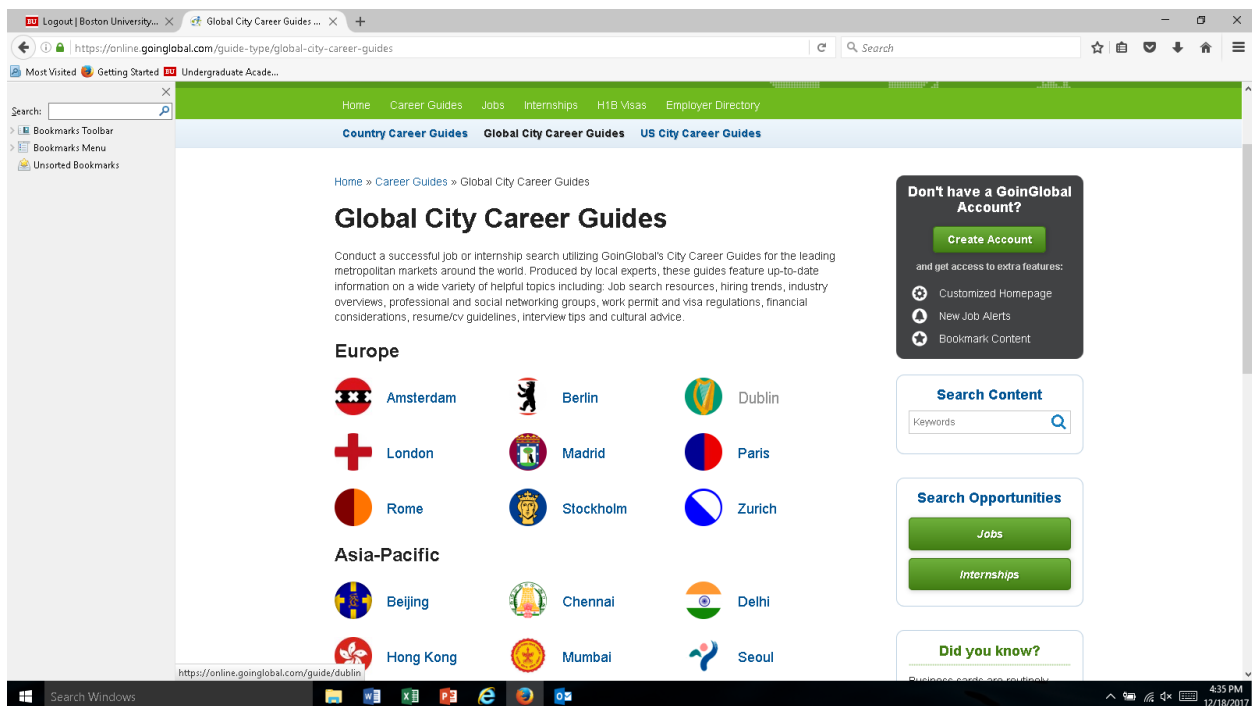
2. On the “Resources” page scroll to the second row and select **“GoinGlobal-Career Guides by Country.”**



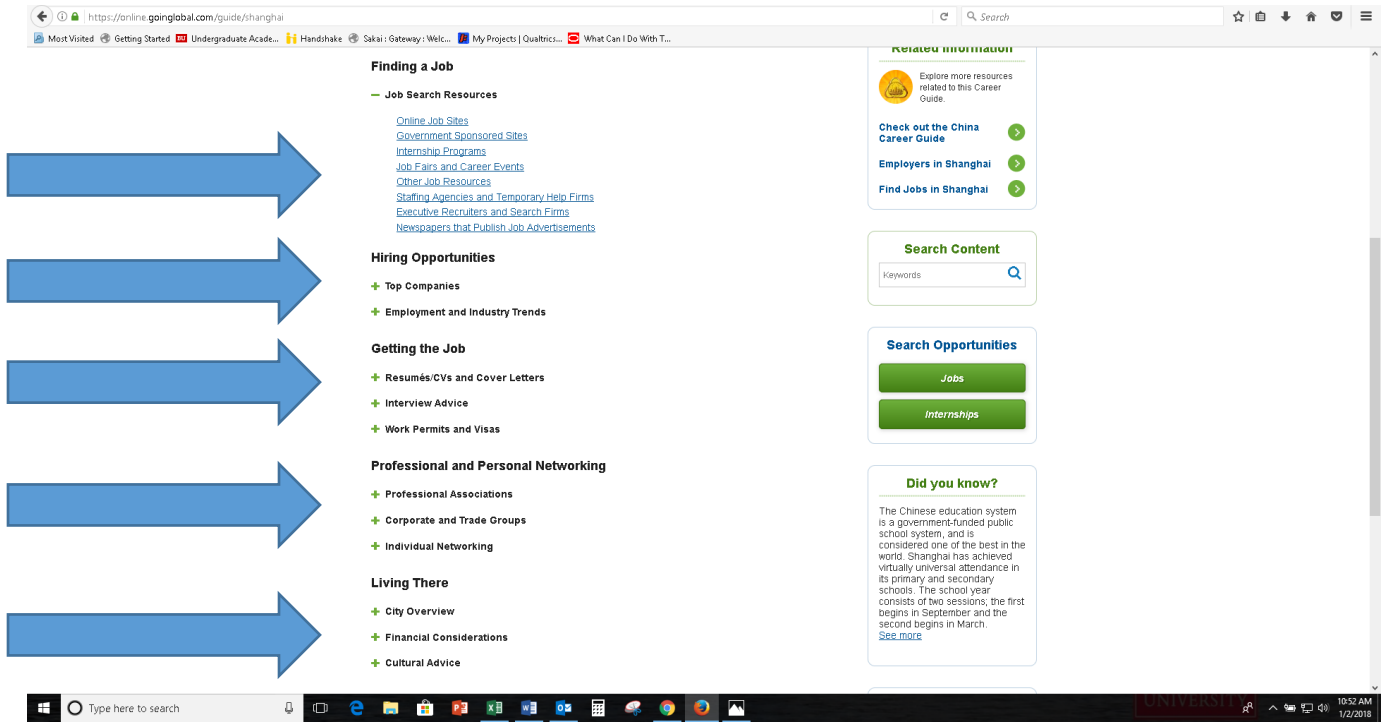
3. To find out information on specific cities' career guides, place your cursor over **"Career Guides"** located on the top bar.

H1B VISAS DATABASE

On the GoInGlobal home page, click on “**H1B Visas**” on the top bar. You can search by occupation, company, year/(s), or location to find further information on salary ranges based on company name, occupation, industry, and job title. The database also contains certified visa application records from 2009 - to-date and employers that have recorded hiring international professionals with your similar skill set.
