## Intra-University Transfer (IUT) to Questrom: Common Questions

1. **I am a BU student and want to transfer to Questrom. How can I learn more? Who can I talk to?**
  - a. A good place to start is your **home college advising office**. Advisors in your home school can recommend courses to take prior to and while enrolled in the Questrom gateway courses (SM131 & FE101).
  - b. **Visit the UDC website**. Details about the IUT **process**, including the mandatory information sessions, can be found here: <http://questromworld.bu.edu/udc/transfers/transfers-within-bu/>
  - c. Visit the **Center for Career Development (CCD)**. The first step in choosing a major is to understand yourself. Majors do not have to determine the course of the rest of your life. Think about your academic interests, attend a workshop on choosing a major, explore department websites, and see one of the career counselors in the CCD who can help guide you through the process of choosing a major. Use the resources at the CCD to help make the best decision—for you. (100 Bay State Road, <http://www.bu.edu/careers/>)
2. **I am a BU student and want to transfer to Questrom. What is the process?**
  - a. First step: attend a mandatory **information session** to have many of your questions answered. Students are encouraged to attend a session prior to enrolling in the Questrom gateway courses (SM131 & FE101). 3. **Are there certain classes I need to take before transferring to Questrom? Do I need to achieve a certain grade?**
  - a. Yes, students must complete Questrom’s required gateway courses, SM131 and FE101, and earn a grade of B- or better in each. If a student repeats a gateway course, the average of the two grades for the course must be at least a B- (2.70).
  - b. Students earning less than a 2.70 average in either SM 131 or FE 101 are not eligible to transfer to the Questrom School of Business. Students may continue taking Questrom courses to pursue the Business Administration minor. See question #11 for more information about the minor.
4. **Do I need a certain GPA to transfer?**
  - a. In addition to other IUT requirements, students must attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher. All Incomplete (“I”) grades in academic courses must be resolved prior to transfer.
5. **I am thinking of transferring to Questrom. Will I still graduate in 4 years?**
  - a. Generally speaking, most students who IUT to Questrom graduate on time. The Questrom curriculum is sequential in nature so students should plan on a minimum of 5-6 semesters to finish required coursework. 6. **I need help planning my courses for this semester. How do I know if the classes I have taken or am registered for will fulfill Questrom requirements?**
  - a. Attend a mandatory information session where this will be addressed.

7. I will finish the gateway courses this semester. What courses should I register for next semester?

8. The gateway courses are full. What do I do?

10. Does Questrom have a business minor? Can I customize it to my interests?
  - a. Non-Questrom students are eligible to complete the Business Administration minor. A minimum grade of C- is required in the following classes: SM 131, FE 101, AC 221, AC 222, OB 221, QM 221, EC 101, EC 102.
