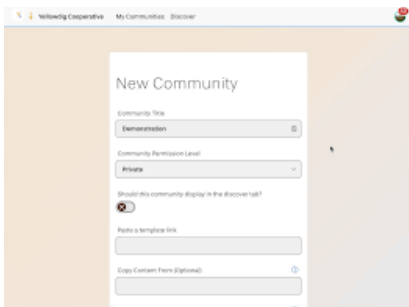


Using Yellow Dig for Class Discussion

Yellow Dig communities are grouped by class. Request Yellow Dig to be added to your Questrom Tools site from ITS.

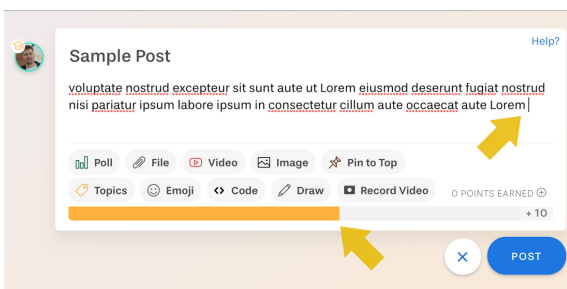
MAKE YELLOW DIG ONE GRADED ASSIGNMENT

Earning Points

- + Creating a new **Pin** with a minimum of 40 words earns 10 points.
- + Adding a new **Comment** with a minimum of 40 words earns 5 points.
- + **Upvoting** a Comment or Pin (Like or Love) earns author 1 points.
- + Receiving an **Instructor Badge** earns 10 points.
- + Receiving a **Comment** on a Pin will earn Pin author 0 points.
- + **100%** participation achieved after earning 100 points (passed back to gradebook if enabled).

Students will have multiple opportunities to interact with the community and conversations, thus adding to their overall points over the course of a semester.

STUDENTS EARN POINTS FOR POSTS AND COMMENTS.



Rather than all students responding to the same prompt, students should be encouraged to post their own course relevant content and respond to each other's posts. Encourage the students to use tags and hashtags to make their posts searchable.
