Please arrive at Long Wharf no later than 7:30AM.

Please arrive to Long Wharf no later than 7:30AM for checkin. Do not be late – you will be left behind! If you miss the boat, you will miss the entire day's experience. There is no other way or time to get to Thompson Island.

Dock Location is Long Wharf. You should look for everyone in their cohort T-shirts! We will probably be on the boardwalk between Long Wharf and Old Atlantic Ave.

Note that the nearest T stop is Aquarium, but Haymarket, State Street, Government Center, and Downtown Crossing are also within walking distance.

Please budget enough time to get all the way to Long Wharf.

You will be spending most of your time outdoors, so please dress appropriately for the time of year keeping in mind that it is usually windier and a few degrees cooler on the island than on the mainland.

Here are a few suggestions:

- Dress in layers it is much easier to take off layers as the day warms than to start out with too little! Clothing should be loose and comfortable. Athletic clothes are welcome. DO BRING a full CHANGE of CLOTHES and SHOES and a small towel! WEAR YOUR COHORT T-SHIRT TO START THE DAY!
- Wear comfortable, sturdy, close-toed shoes with good traction that can get wet. (It's an Island, after all!).
- Bring some water, sun hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, and bug spray!
- Bring a small pack to carry your items in.
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided, but we recommend bringing a packed lunch if you keep a vegan or kosher diet.
- Bring your ID (and something to keep it dry) if you might go out with classmates afterward.
