Tasks to Complete Before Arriving to Campus

Register for LAUNCH - You can expect to receive an email in the coming weeks with a unique link to a LAUNCH Registration Form, sent from mbacenter@bu.edu.

- **Due: As soon as possible; no later than August 10th**
- As a reminder, LAUNCH is a required on-campus orientation from Wednesday, August 19th - Monday, August 31st. The information being collected via this form is essential for us to prepare materials for LAUNCH.

Academic Pre-Work

- **Due: August 24th at 11:59pm**

- All incoming FT MBA students will be added to a course in Blackboard by the end of this week titled ***Pre-Work - FT MBA Fall 2026*** for the Mod 1 core courses. Please take some time to log into the site and complete your required academic pre-work to prepare you for your Fall courses. You should allow about 40 hours of total prep time. For those with prior background, the time required should be less.
- If for any reason you are not seeing the pre-work course listed on your dashboard please contact the MBA Center at mbacenter@bu.edu.

Upload a Terrier Card Photo

- **Due: As soon as possible; before August 10th for LAUNCH pick-up**
- Your Terrier card is your BU student ID, which will allow you swipe access to the student lounge, the Pardee library and other campus resources.
- **Anyone who uploads their ID photo before August 10th, we will have your ID ready for you to pick up when you arrive for LAUNCH.** Those who submit after August 10th will need to follow up with the Terrier Card Office to coordinate pick up from 25 Buick Street.

Incoming Student Health Requirements

- Please review this website to know what the university needs prior to your arrival, including medical records and immunization requirements.

Disability/Access

MBTA Pass

- Those interested in purchasing Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) Semester Passes for the 2026 Fall semester must [apply](#) by the deadline, **Monday, August 10**. Most of you will be registered for courses within the next couple of weeks, so you will be able to apply after that date.
