What Classes Will You Be Taking?

The first classes every Part-Time MBA student takes as they enter their MBA program are **MO712: Leading Organizations and People**, and if you indicated you would like to take two

courses or are in the Cohort track, you will also take **AC711: Financial Reporting and Control**.

Your academic advisor will be registering you for your first semester courses, so there is nothing you need to do for registration. They will be reaching out to you in late July via email to introduce themselves, and will let you know when your schedule is available to view on your [MyBU Student Portal](#).

If you received waivers for one of these courses, MBA Center advisors will be reaching out to identify an appropriate alternative course for your first semester.

Academic Pre-work

All incoming Part-Time MBA student will be added to a course in [Blackboard](#) in the coming weeks for the Accounting core course titled **Pre-Work – PTMBA Fall 2026**. If you will not be taking AC711 this Fall, you may either use this course as an accounting refresher, or ignore it.

For those of you who are registered for AC711 this Fall, we encourage you to utilize this tool in preparation for the course. Please allow about 15-20 hours of total prep time. For those with prior background, the time required should be less.

Tasks to Complete Before Arriving to Campus

Register for LAUNCH - You can expect to receive an email in the coming weeks with a unique link to a LAUNCH Registration Form, sent from mbacenter@bu.edu.

- **Due: As soon as possible; no later than August 10th**
- As a reminder, LAUNCH is a required on-campus orientation on Wednesday, August 19th. The information being collected via this form is essential for us to prepare materials for LAUNCH.

Upload a Terrier Card Photo

- **Due: As soon as possible; before August 10th for LAUNCH pick-up**
- Your Terrier card is your BU student ID, which will allow you swipe access to the student lounge, the Pardee library and other campus resources.
- **Anyone who uploads their ID photo before August 10th, we will have your ID ready for you to pick up when you arrive for LAUNCH.** Those who submit after August 10th will need to follow up with the Terrier Card Office to coordinate pick up from 25 Buick Street.

Incoming Student Health Requirements

- Take a look at this site to know what the university needs prior to your arrival, including medical records and immunization requirements.

Career Pre-Work

(for all incoming PTMBA students no matter what your circumstances)

- **Due: Sept. 1st** – Submit to Peter DeCotis pdecotis@bu.edu
- Order, download and read the book **“The 2-hour Job Search”** by Steve Dalton (free in Spotify if you have a membership or search your local libraries). It’s very short.
- Create your LAMP list of companies, advocates, motivation and postings (from the book).
- Send you LAMP list to your career coach, Peter DeCotis at pdecotis@bu.edu
- Send a one-page review of the book to Peter DeCotis, answering these questions:
 - Why create a LAMP list and how can it help you?
 - Explain why randomly applying to jobs online doesn’t usually work.
 - What does Steve mean by “naturalize”?
 - What does the author say is the key to finding a job and why?

- If you plan to commute by car to campus, please review parking guidelines on the [Student Permit](#) page and follow the instructions there to purchase a parking pass.

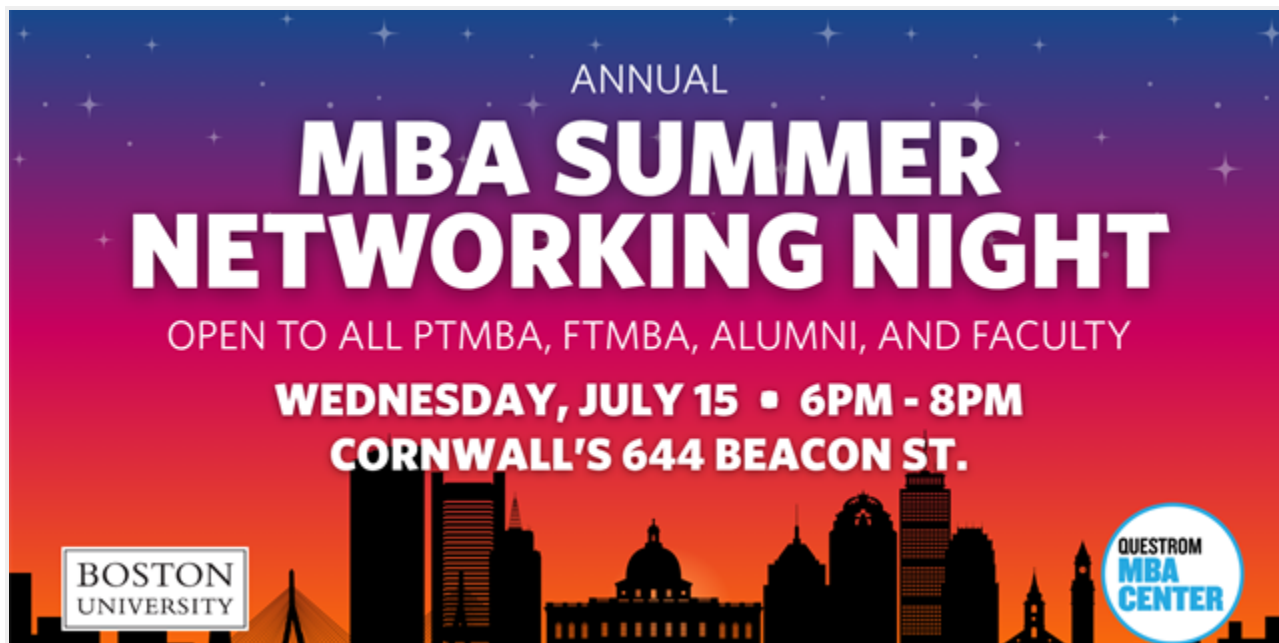
