Questrom Pre-Requisites

Students must have completed their Core courses (FE 323, MK 323, OM 323, QM 323).

Approved Courses

Students take **five** courses for a total of sixteen US credits while in Dublin. Three of the courses must be Business courses. Classes *other than the internship class* are taken at **University College Dublin (UCD)**.

A typical course load in Dublin comprises:

- QST IM 430 – Internship and corresponding seminar (mandatory) – 4 BU credits **earns IIC Hub unit*
 - CAS HI 3XX – Choice of Irish History Course (mandatory) – 3 BU credits*
 - 3 Management Course – 3 BU credits each*
- *Irish classes earning 5 ECTS come back as 3 BU Credits.*

Important Notes

1. Students may take up to **two concentration courses** abroad per concentration; of these, only **one** can fulfill an **A List** requirement.
2. Students are **unable** to fulfill HUB units through courses taken at University College Dublin; but may earn GCI Hub through the [Study Abroad and the Hub](#) credit option.
