Pre-Requisites

Students must have completed QST Core courses (MK/QM/OM/FE 323) as well as 5 semesters of college-level Spanish.

Approved Courses

Students take **four** courses for a total of **16** credits; at least one must be a management course. A typical course load in Madrid comprises:

- QST IM430 – Internship and corresponding seminar (mandatory) – 4 credits*
 - CAS LS3XX or 4XX – Upper-Level Spanish course (mandatory) – 4 credits*
 - Management Course – 4 credits
 - Management Course or liberal arts course – 4 credits
- *IM430 & CAS LS are taken through the Instituto Internacional en España in Madrid.
Students take their other courses at the Universidad Pontificia Comillas – ICADE*

Important Notes

- Students may take up to up to **two concentration courses** abroad per concentration; of these, only **one** can fulfill an **A List** requirement.
- Students are **unable** to fulfill HUB units through courses taken at the Universidad Pontificia Comillas – ICADE

Typical Course Enrollment:

- QST IM430 – Internship in Management; earns IIC Hub
- CAS LS3XX or 4XX – Upper-Level Spanish course; applies to CAS/Non-Questrom elective; Hubs as applicable

- **Select two additional courses:** *This is not an exclusive list and course offerings are subject to change.* Course approval is **required** for **any** course (both management and non-management) not listed below. *Please send courses of interest to Kelly Sachleben for review: kellycs@bu.edu.
